The World Bank, IDA, ESMAP, and GCF are funding Guinea-Bissau's first solar power plants with a \$78.15 million investment to support decarbonization and expand electricity access. The project will build solar plants near Bissau and install mini-grids on the Bijagos islands, thereby providing electricity to 1,200 households and SMEs.

A 30 MW solar power plant will be developed near the capital, Bissau, to reduce electricity costs and diversify the energy mix.

What is the solar energy scale-up & access project?

The Solar Energy Scale-up and Access Project is expected to benefit residential, commercial, and industrial consumers nationwide-- including those on the islands. It aligns with the government's strategy to encourage private sector participation, stimulate economic growth, and create sustainable job opportunities.
