Where is solar PV potential found in Denmark?

How much solar power does Denmark have?

Denmark ranks 37th in the world for cumulative solar PV capacity, with 1,540 total MW"sof solar PV installed. This means that 4.10% of Denmark"s total energy as a country comes from solar PV (that 's 19th in the world).

What is the ideal angle to tilt solar PV panels in Denmark?

So far based on Solar PV Analysis of 127 locations in Denmark,we"ve discovered that the ideal angle to tilt solar PV panels in Denmark varies between 48°from the horizontal plane facing South in Hirtshals and 45° from the horizontal plane facing South in Rønne.
