Can solar panels be removed and reinstalled?

Often, solar panel removal and reinstallation happen to allow for roof repair. To avoid the unnecessary cost of removing and reinstalling solar panels, repair or fix a new roof while installing solar panels. Fixing a new roof requires that solar panels be removed and reinstalled anew.

When will my solar panels be reinstalled?

Once your roof is back in good condition and/or your solar panel system has been repaired, your panels will be reinstalled. The solar installer may recommend new or upgraded components. Once your solar panels are up again, the system will be reviewed to ensure everything works properly.

How long does a solar reinstall take?

Once the roof repair or replacement is complete, the solar installers will return (usually within two weeks, depending on weather and scheduling) to reinstall racking, wiring, and the solar panels. Your system will then be reenergized and recommissioned to ensure it is functioning properly before the reinstallation crew closes out the job.
