How do I reset an AP to factory default settings?

Complete the following steps to reset an AP to its factory default settings. Click an AP name to view details about the AP. Click the name of the AP that you want to reset to factory default settings. The AP information page is displayed. In the upper-right corner of the page, click Manage to display a menu, and click Factory Reset.

How do I restore the factory settings of an AP?

You can delete the current and historical user configurations and restore the factory settings of APs. When the configuration on an AP is incorrect or deleted, you can restore the factory settings of the AP. Restoring the factory settings of an AP will reset the AP and restore all the AP configurations to factory settings.

How do I Reset my AP settings?

The AP information page is displayed. In the upper-right corner of the page, click Manage to display a menu, and click Factory Reset. A confirmation message is displayed. Click Reset to Factory Settings. If you want to erase all of the settings that you have configured on an AP, you can reset it to its factory default settings.

What happens after a factory reset on a UNIFI AP?

A factory reset wipes the UniFi AP clean. It removes: After a reset, the AP goes back to its default state. The LED usually turns white, meaning it's ready to be adopted again.
