The NREP defines "renewable energy" as referring to "small hydro (equal to or less than 30MW), solar, wind, geothermal, biofuels and biomassand other such clean energy sources approved by the Ministry responsible for Energy in Zimbabwe".

Who is responsible for the energy sector in Zimbabwe?

The MOEPDhas overall responsibility for the energy sector in Zimbabwe. It is responsible for policy formulation and implementation, an oversight role over the government-owned utilities (ZETDC and ZPC), ZRA jointly with Zambia and the activities of ZERA.
